Student Materials List

- sketchbook
 - pencils and erasers
 - conte in black, sanguine & white (or pastels)
 - Some sort of easy, quick colour drawing media: coloured conte, chalk pastels, colour pencils, etc.
 - Scissors, ruler, painter's masking tape
 - Block or pad of economical 140lb watercolour paper or mixed media paper, 12x16"-ish. Canson XL or Strathmore Vision are good options.
 - You can do all the work on the watercolour paper – but if desired, you can have a couple of canvasses and/or wood panels on hand as options

- Paints in the medium of your choice. Acrylics are easiest, IMHO – but watercolour, gouache or oil can also work

Here's a convenient minimalist palette, consisting of a warm and a cool version of each primary, plus black and white:

- Cadmium or Hansa Yellow Medium AND Lemon Yellow or Hansa or Cadmium Yellow Light
- Cadmium or Naphthol Red Medium AND Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Violet or Quinacridone Magenta
- Phthalo Blue Green Shade AND Ultramarine Blue
- Black (larger size)
- White (larger size)
- Other colours as desired
- Mediums as desired

- Your usual arsenal of painting tools: brushes, palette knives, palette, etc.
- phone (for camera)
